



Prenatal care for clients without insurance

Most clients without insurance can get care at Johns Hopkins at Bayview or Baltimore Medical Systems. Talk to a Health Care for the Homeless Case Manager if you need help getting care.

Johns Hopkins at Bayview SPRNAT (self-pay program)

4940 Eastern Ave. Baltimore, MD 21224

You are:

- Not eligible for insurance (or have run out of insurance benefits)
- Not able to afford prenatal care

You must:

- Have a positive pregnancy test
- Live in one of these zip codes: 21213, 21220, 21205, 21206, 21221, 21224, 21231, 21222 or 21237
- Bring a form of ID (example: passport)
 - If you do not have an ID, Health Care for the Homeless can print a medical visit note to serve as an ID
- Bring proof of income if you or your spouse work (example: last 3 paystubs or bank statements)
- Bring a copy of your last year's taxes if you file taxes
- Bring proof of address with your name (example: a utility bill addressed to you)
 - Health Care for the Homeless can provide a letter stating your address if you do not have other proof
- Bring a notarized letter from the person who supports you if you are single and do not work.

- Walk-in to the Johns Hopkins Bayview campus Financial Counseling office with all required documents
 - Located at 4940 Eastern Avenue. Enter via the 'Bayview Medical Offices (BMO)' entrance with the blue awning and turn left past security.
 - Your first prenatal appointment cannot be scheduled until you submit all required documents in person

Baltimore Medical System (BMS)

BMS will see you no matter how far along you are in your pregnancy

You must:

- Bring a form of ID (example: passport)
 - If you do not have an ID, Health Care for the Homeless can print a medical visit note to serve as an ID
- Call 443-703-3600 to schedule appointment
 - They will recommend the location closest to you:
 - East Baltimore Medical Center
 - St. Agnes
 - Highlandtown
 - Belair-Edison
 - Pine Heights
 - Middlesex
 - Most clients can schedule an appointment within 2 weeks
 - Your first visit will be with a financial health benefit advisor/case manager
 - You will be charged on a sliding fee scale—the lowest cost is \$25 per visit

If pregnant, you can access these prenatal services without insurance. It may be harder to pay for them or schedule an appointment.
